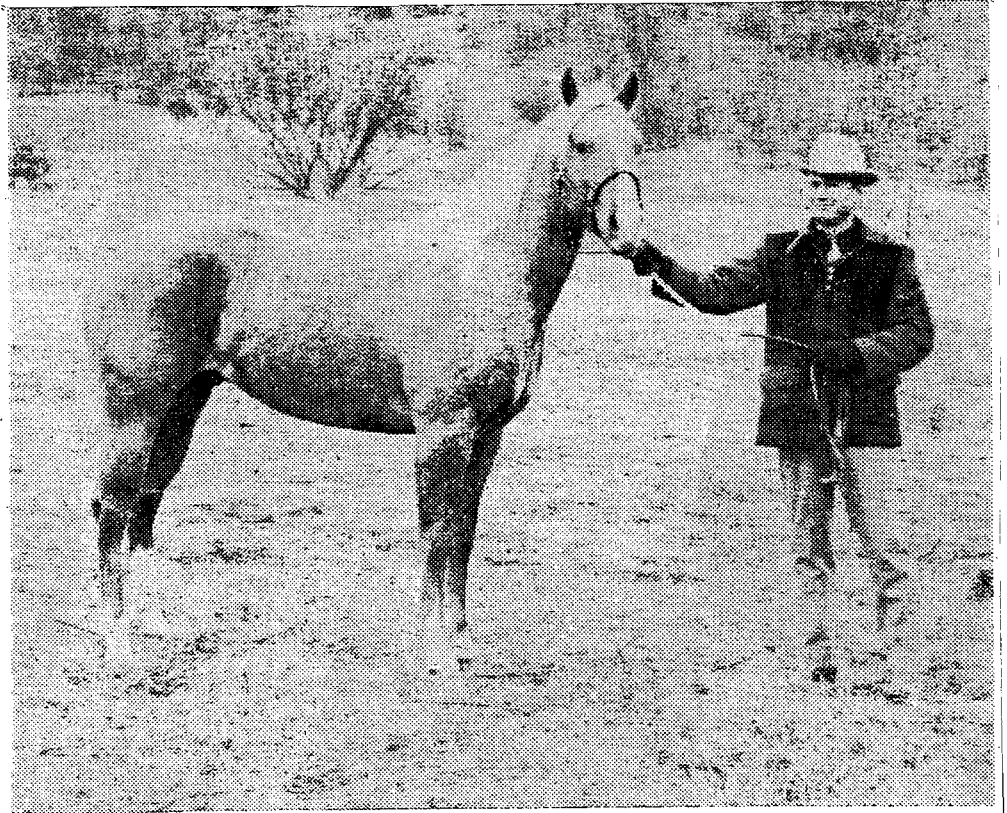


\$10,000 Worth of Horse

This section of Kansas and Oklahoma need never hang its head before famous horse country when it can produce horses like Yellow King Bailey, Guy Rutland's Grand Champion Palomino Stallion pictured above.

Mr Ruthland, young stockman and farmer in Osage County, 11 miles south of Sedan, purchased the horse when a colt for 1200 dollars. By Hank H out of Beauty Bailey the stallion was foaled June 5, 1945.

Only this fall has Mr Ruthland begun to show Yellow King Bailey and in two of the biggest shows in the country he has easily carried

off Grand Champion honors. Both the National Western Stock Show at Denver and the Southwest exposition at Ft Worth awarded him the blue rosette of the Grand Champion.

Weighing close to 1,000 pounds the perfectly formed stallion, with the classic golden palomino color is a magnificent animal. Conservative estimates place his value at \$10,000 since his latest show ring wins.

Mr Ruthland intends to keep Yellow King Bailey however for breeding purposes and for a show horse who should have many more grand champion awards before him.
